On behalf of the Parish, we thank the volunteer coordinators, the adult teachers and helpers who served the parish with dedication this year in our Children's Liturgy Program at the Sunday 10 am Mass.

In a special way, we want to thank some former teachers and student helpers (past and present), who stepped forward to help our younger group when we were short of teachers in May and June.

A special thank also to the new student helpers that joined our program this year, volunteering with the younger children--showing up early to set up the rooms, staying late to clean up after each program, and working very well with the children.

The Children's Liturgy Program will resume near the end of September 2018.


