The Archdiocesan Mission Co-Operative Program plays an important role in connecting the parishes of the Archdiocese of Toronto with the Catholic Church in other parts of the world. This year, we are pleased to introduce our parishioners and community to **Fr. Clifford Sherwin from the Diocese of Ratnapura.**

The Diocese of Ratnapura is a rural and mission diocese, located in a deprived area of the northern region of the country. It was carved out of the Diocese of Galle and borders the Archdiocese of Colombo. The diocese of Ratnapura consists of very very poor and marginalized people who are really being battered very heavily with day to day needs. Very many families live a hand to mouth life. Most of the children struggle to continue their schooling due to poverty of their parents and as a result many stay at home and others top half way and spend the time idling. The standard of living is very very pathetic. Many survive with one or two meals. Very many don't have their basic needs and just rough out. The health issues are huge. We serve in one of the poorest dioceses on the planet. Very many children come to the church on Sundays with empty stomachs. No proper clothing. The diocese as such the challenges are huge. We have the Grace of Good God we move forward. For us travelling is a huge huge problem. People live in far away places and on mountains.
