- 1st Reading:** 1 Kings 17.10-16
Responsorial Psalms: Ps. 146.6c-7, 8-9a, 9b-10
Second Reading: Hebrews 9.24-28
Gospel: Mark 12.38-44



In the gospel reading, Jesus reminds us that our responsibility as children of God is a dual one, that love of God and love of neighbour are inseparably linked. We cannot claim to love God if we ignore those around us. St. Augustine said, "Love God and do as you will for the soul trained in loving God will do nothing to offend the One who is Beloved."

In the first letter of St. John, we read "My dear friends, let us love one another, for love comes from God. Those who do not love have not known God, for God is love." And then John makes this point: "This is love — not that we loved God, but God first loved us." God first loved us.

Once we really begin to let that sink in — God first loved us — then, of course, our response will be to try to love in return. To be grateful, to be filled with gratitude, with joy, and to begin to experience the peace and the goodness of all that God is.
