The second **World Day of the Poor** will be observed on Sunday, November 18, 2018. In his apostolic letter to close the Year of Mercy, Pope Francis suggested the Catholic Church set aside one day each year when communities can “reflect on how poverty is at the very heart of the Gospel.” It is an opportunity for Catholics to deepen their solidarity with the poor and to bring Christ’s love to those suffering from material and spiritual poverty.

The theme chosen for this year’s message is **“This poor man cried, and the Lord heard him”**. *Psalms 34: 7*

In his message, Pope Francis calls the World Day of the Poor **“a small answer”** the Church gives to the poor “lest they think that their cry has gone unheard. It may well be like a drop of water in the desert of poverty, yet it can serve as a sign of sharing with those in need and enable them to sense the active presence of a brother or a sister. The poor do not need intermediaries, but the personal involvement of all those who hear their cry.”
