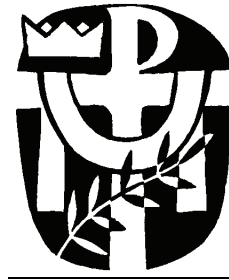
**Living the Gospel by supporting those with disabilities**
