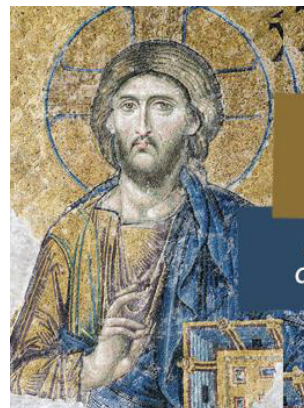
Living the Gospel by supporting at-risk youth
