SEASON OF CREATION

This weekend begins the **Season of Creation, 2019**, celebrated around the world. You may watch an inspiring video from our faith leaders #ForTheLoveOfCreation. We are also seeing youth around the world, and here in Toronto, taking leadership in calling for immediate, urgent attention to Climate Change. We are all called to look concretely at how we will care for creation and make a difference in combating Climate Change.

The theme chosen for the **Season of Creation** this year is “the *Web of Life*”. This is a magnificent image to help us realize how interconnected we are to all aspects of life. In the words of Pope Francis in **Laudato Si’**, “Nature cannot be regarded as something separate from ourselves or as a mere setting in which we live. We are part of nature, included in it, and thus in constant interaction with it.” We cannot remove ourselves from the suffering of the Earth, and the consequent suffering of those most vulnerable.
