In today's Gospel we hear Jesus teach about faith and service to God. The context is a continuing dialogue between Jesus and his followers about what it means to be a disciple of Jesus. Jesus has just finished an instruction on sin and forgiveness. In the wake of that demanding teaching, his apostles ask Jesus to increase their faith. Jesus responds by assuring them that even the smallest amount of faith has powerful effects. Then he tells them a story about a servant and his master. Jesus seems to be suggesting to the apostles that their faith will increase by their daily following of him, through their day-in, day-out service in his name.

It is through our daily efforts to be faithful to God, to live our faith in the everyday, that our bond with God is strengthened. It is in and through such everyday fidelity that God becomes more real to us and we are drawn closer to God.
