Having celebrated the Solemnity of All Saints and of the Commemoration of the faithful departed, this Sunday's Liturgy invites us once again to reflect upon the mystery of the resurrection of the dead. The Gospel presents Jesus confronted by several Sadducees, who did not believe in the resurrection. In response to the Sadducee's question Jesus emphasizes the truth of the resurrection, explaining that life after death will be different from that on earth.

However, if we live our life in a loving and whole-hearted way, we need not be worried about what is waiting for us on "the other side."
