In this year's **World Day of the Poor message**, celebrated on 17 November 2019, Pope Francis reflects on **Psalm 9:19**, "The hope of the poor will not perish forever." In his message Pope Francis writes, "The situation of the poor obliges us not to keep our distance from the body of the Lord, who suffers in them. Instead, we are called to touch his flesh and to be personally committed in offering a service that is an authentic form of evangelization" (no. 6) God uses any number of ways and countless means to reach people's hearts. The poor need our hands, to be lifted up; our hearts, to feel anew the warmth of affection; our presence, to overcome loneliness. In a word, they need love" (no. 8). Pope Francis urges us to be authentic witnesses of Christian hope and to accompany the poor through a personal and constant commitment over time.
