**Mary, the Mother of God—World Day of Prayer for Peace** – New Year’s Day is designated as a Solemnity in honor of Mary, the Mother of God. For the last 52 years, it has also been the occasion for the Pope to issue a message of peace for all the world. The theme chosen by Pope Francis for 2020 is **“Peace as a journey of hope: Dialogue, reconciliation and ecological conversion.”**

In his message, Pope Francis recalled his meeting with survivors of the atomic bombs dropped on Hiroshima and Nagasaki on his recent apostolic journey to Japan. He said that their testimony bears witness to succeeding generations of the unspeakable suffering and horror caused by the bombings. The pope called for the elimination of nuclear weapons and reiterated his message that “peace and international stability are incompatible with attempts to build upon the fear of mutual destruction or the threat of total annihilation.”

In his message the Pope says that in order to establish peace, nations must learn to resolve conflicts through dialogue, and must undergo an “ecological conversion” to protect the environment and foster recognition of our shared humanity.
