R.C.I.A. Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults

Who: We welcome all those who are interested in learning about, or joining, our faith community. Our RCIA Program is intended for four groups of people:

2. For those who have been **baptized in a Christian church that is not Catholic**. These people would not be re-baptized (or re-confirmed); they would, however, experience the rite of being received into full communion with the Catholic Christian Church.
3. For those who were baptized as Roman Catholics, but who have **not received the Sacraments of Confirmation, the Eucharist or Reconciliation**.
4. Those who **wish to update his/her faith**.

Attending our RCIA program **does not imply that you are committed** to joining our faith community.
