On November 1<sup>st</sup> we celebrate the **Feast of All Saints**, in which we celebrate ‘all the saints’ canonized and not, who are models for us of living the Gospel. On Monday, we celebrate **All Souls Day**, a day on which we remember all of the holy souls who have passed from this world to the next and journey to God. Pope Francis says that “the two great feasts we celebrate– All Saints Day and All Souls Day – are celebrations of hope and it is important to think about hope.” The early Christians used an anchor as a symbol of hope, he said, and “to have our hearts anchored up there where our loved ones are, where the saints are, where Jesus is, where God is -- that is hope.”


