### **October 1 and 2 Collection: Healing and Reconciliation**

Friday, Sept. 30 is the National Day for Truth and Reconciliation. A parish collection, in support of Indigenous Healing and Reconciliation, will be held on the weekend of Oct. 1 and 2, 2022. In January 2022, the Archdiocese of Toronto committed to being a major contributor toward the Catholic bishops in Canada's pledge to raise \$30 million to support Indigenous reconciliation initiatives. 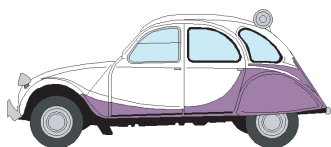
