

For whom?

We welcome all those who are interested in learning about, or joining, our Roman Catholic faith community.

Our RCIA Program is intended for FOUR groups of people:

- 1. For those who have **never been baptized**, but who are interested in learning more about the Roman Catholic Church.
- 2. For those who have been **baptized in a Christian church that is not Catholic**. These people would not be rebaptized (or re-confirmed); they would, however, experience the rite of being **received into full communion with the Catholic Christian Church**.
- 3. For those who were **baptized as Roman Catholics**, but who have not received the Sacraments of Confirmation, the Eucharist, or Reconciliation.
- 4. Those who wish to update their understanding of their faith.
