Dear Parishioners,

I would like to draw your attention to two important matters:

**Sacramental Preparations:** Sacramental preparations—for children and adults—are an important part of Parishes. We prepare parents when they request for their child's baptism; we prepare children and their parents for First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion and for the Sacrament of Confirmation; we prepare adults for the sacraments of Initiation through the R.C.I.A. program and we prepare couples for their marriages. Here at Holy Name, we have already begun our preparations for First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion. Our R.C.I.A candidates meet together with our Parish R.C.I.A. team every Wednesday evenings for their preparation sessions. We will begin the preparations for the Sacrament of Confirmation with a meeting for the parents and guardians of our Confirmation candidates this Tuesday, November 21 at 7.00 pm. Most of these sacraments will take place around Easter time. However, it is important that we assist all those preparing for the Sacraments through our Parish's prayers. Therefore, I invite you to keep all of them in your regular prayers.

World Day of the Poor: Every year the Church celebrates the World Day of the Poor on November 19. Pope Francis instituted this celebration in 2017. He encouraged the Church to "go forth", beyond its own walls, to encounter poverty "in the multiple meanings in which it manifests itself in today's world." "Do not look away from the poor," is the theme for the year 2023. Pope Francis begins his message for the day by stressing that "a great river of poverty is

traversing our cities and swelling to the point of overflowing; it seems to overwhelm us, so great are the needs of our brothers and sisters who plead for our help, support and solidarity." The above statement of the Pope is so relevant for our own neighbourhoods and for our city. The number of people and families that have to rely on food banks to get through the month are increasing. As a Parish community we try to support the poor in our neighbourhood through our Vincent de Paul Society and through our support to agencies that help the poor. However, let us pray for all the poor in the world on this special day and pledge to help them according to our abilities.
