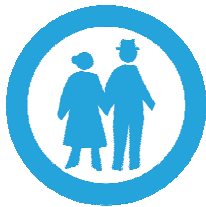
Dear Parishioners,

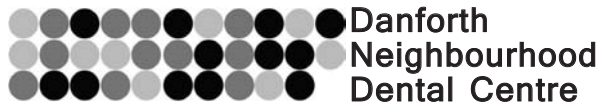

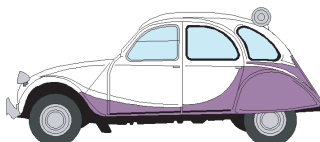
