I can hardly believe that we are already entering the month of October. Time seems to move so quickly, but here we are. Personally, though, this is probably my favourite time of the year. The weather is cool and comfortable, the leaves change colour, and somehow the smell of the air seems uplifting.

The beginning of October also brings us to some beautiful celebrations for our faith. The very first day, **October 1<sup>st</sup>, is the Feast of St. Therese of Lisieux.** She is quite a special saint, and many people have a great devotion to her. I am definitely one of them. St. Therese has been very important in my own life as a priest. Getting to know about her life and reading her letters have been very inspiring, but more importantly, her prayers and love that she showers down from heaven have often been a source of help and comfort. We have a beautiful statue of St. Therese in our church, just over the door to the chapel. I encourage you to turn to St. Therese in times of need...she won't let you down!

The next day, **October 2<sup>nd</sup>, is the Feast of the Guardian Angels.** Our faith teaches us that one of the ways by which God's love and protection comes to us is through the angels. Each of us, in fact, has a special guardian angel. We don't see or hear the angels, but it is well worth turning to the guardian angels regularly and asking for their help in certain situations. The angels will also not let us down!

Here at Holy Name, we have a beautiful stained-glass window of the guardian angels. See if you can find it, and then say that classic prayer together:

"Angel of God, my guardian dear, to whom God's love commits me here. Ever this day be at my side, to light and guard, to rule and guide. Amen!"

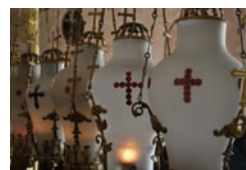

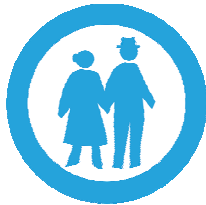

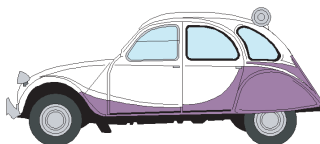
