Dear parishioners,

In a recent letter for All Souls' Day, Archbishop Leo wrote that one of the best ways to assist our deceased relatives and friends is to "have holy Mass offered for them". The remembrance of the dead during Mass is an ancient tradition. We believe that at Mass, the Body and Blood of Jesus, offered to the heavenly Father, bring for us powerful graces and blessings. Those who have died benefit greatly from those graces as they await their entry into heaven. When we offer a Mass for a specific intention, we believe that person is able to benefit in a particular way. We can also offer Mass intentions for specific needs of those who are still living – for healing, for guidance, or in thanksgiving. Of course, at every Mass we are always praying for so many people, so many needs. All of those intentions are indeed lifted up to God. Nevertheless, offering Mass intentions is a beautiful way to focus our hearts on particular needs.

It is also a common practice to give an offering for a Mass intention, as an act of charity and to assist with church expenses. Such a gift is very much **an offering and not a payment**. The grace of God is available to all and does not have a price; we do not need to pay for the sacraments. Regular expenses do occur, though, and so such offerings are given out of charity. Given the large number of Catholics in the world, the Church has issued guidelines in order to keep things organized and fair. In general, only one offering is accepted per Mass, for the intentions of the donor. However, it is permitted to have **up to two Masses per week with multiple intentions**. Therefore, please note the following practice here at Holy Name Parish, in accordance with the guidelines of the Archdiocese of Toronto:

- 12:05 PM Mass on Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday, and the 5PM Mass on Saturday – these will each have one offering for a single intention.
- Sunday 10 AM Mass – always offered for the people of Holy Name Parish.
- The **12:05 PM Mass on Monday** and the **12 PM Mass on Sunday** are reserved for **multiple intentions**. Several people may give Mass offerings for intentions to be included in these Masses.

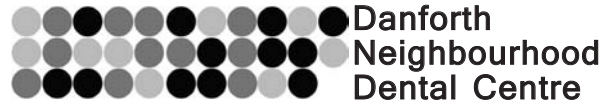

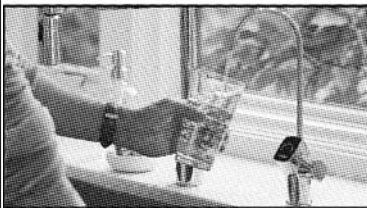
