#### Dear parishioners,

The Advent season tends to draw us close to Our Lady. We think of the journey to Bethlehem and the birth of Jesus – central events in the life of Mary. This upcoming week provides us with some great celebrations for Our Blessed Mother. On Monday, December 9th, we celebrate the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception, Normally, this feast is celebrated on *December 8<sup>th</sup>*, but since this year that date falls on a Sunday, we "bump" the feast to the next day. This great feast commemorates our belief that Our Lady was preserved from all stain of sin from the very moment of her conception. She was "full of grace" from the beginning, completely transformed by the Holy Spirit. It is a feast of hope and gives us confidence to turn to Our Lady in our needs. The very next day, December 10<sup>th</sup>, is the feast of Our Lady of Loreto. The town of Loreto, on the eastern coast of Italy, has for centuries been an important pilgrimage site. Contained in the Basilica of the Holy House, there is a small chapel that enshrines what is considered to be the actual house from Nazareth in which Jesus, Mary, and Joseph lived. I have had the opportunity to spend several days in Loreto, and I found it to be a very prayerful, peaceful place. Finally, December 12th is the feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe. This feast commemorates the miraculous appearance of Our Lady to Juan Diego in Mexico. The famous image of Our Lady of Guadalupe is venerated throughout the world. Because this apparition shows Our Lady's closeness to the indigenous people of Mexico, December 12th is also the National Day of Prayer in Solidarity with Indigenous Peoples. Let us entrust ourselves and all of these important intentions to Our Lady this week, and may she guide us to a holy Advent.


