Dear parishioners,

This week we will enter the holy season of Lent, beginning with **Ash Wednesday on March 5**th. At Holy Name, we will have 2 Masses that day – **12:05pm and 7pm**. Please consider making the time to attend Mass on that day as it will be a great way to prepare the heart for the following 40 days. Here are some other reminders about the spiritual practices the Church encourages us to do during Lent: Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are the days of **fasting and abstinence**. On these days, we perform some sort of penitential act. By making a sacrifice in a bodily way, our hearts are assisted in order to live our faith in a deeper, more honest way.

Fasting means that we limit the amount of food and drink – typically, it means that on a day of fasting we limit ourselves to one main meal and two smaller meals, with no snacking in between.

Abstinence means that we abstain from eating meat. For most of us, this is also a small sacrifice, and it ought to remind us that Jesus sacrificed his own flesh for us on the Cross. On a day of abstinence, we should also be careful not to overindulge in the "non-meat" foods...strictly speaking, a fancy lobster dinner with extra dessert does not have meat, but it would not really be in the spirit of sacrifice and abstinence! In the Catholic Church, the rule of fasting applies to those who are 18 to 59 years of age, and the rule of abstinence applies to those who are 14 years of age and older. Of course, for those outside of those age groups, it is still a good idea to develop a sense of penance and sacrifice for the Lord.

With any kind of physical penance, we must also remember that the primary goal is the conversion of my heart. It will be of no use to fast, abstain from meat, and have a strong Lenten penance if after the 40 days the practice of my faith has not changed much. Let us keep the ultimate goal in mind as we try to make a good spiritual plan for the next few weeks. A blessed Lent to everyone!


