Dear parishioners,

The season of Lent is a good time to focus on the three pillars of our faith life: prayer, fasting, and charity (almsgiving). They should be a part of our lives throughout the year, but the holy time of Lent can help us to reset or go deeper in certain areas.

When it comes to charity, the Archdiocese of Toronto has its annual ShareLife campaign that begins during Lent. The purpose of ShareLife is to support various agencies that carry out the Church's mission work and that serve the marginalized in our communities and around the world. In 2024, the ShareLife campaign raised over \$18 million, the vast majority of that coming from the parishes. As a result, many different charitable activities could be supported: children and youth, immigrants and refugees, international development and missions, seniors, and special needs. Last year, there was also an awareness of the economic challenges that many are facing due to the rising food costs. To address this, ShareLife – with the assistance of a generous anonymous donor – committed \$750,000 to address the hunger crisis through Food Security Grants.

Here at Holy Name Parish, our 2024 ShareLife campaign raised a total of \$50,656.80, which was over 10% higher than our target goal! This was wonderful news and a clear sign of our parishioners' generosity and desire to assist our neighbours in need. These days, we face economic insecurity, and so the fact that our parish could still raise this amount is an inspiring display of your Christian faith.

One of the major recipients of ShareLife funding is St. Augustine's Seminary. The support of seminarians as they prepare to be our future priests is a very important part of our Christian charity. These young men are not only preparing to serve the Church in Toronto, but indeed from other parts of Canada and the world. Next weekend, we are pleased to welcome one of these seminarians, who will join us for all of our weekend Masses. He is from the Archdiocese of St. John's, Newfoundland, studying at St. Augustine's in Toronto. We look forward to hearing how God has called him and is preparing him for a life of service in the Church, providing a concrete example of the wonderful fruits of your generosity.


