Dear Parishioners,

One of the initial questions that many of us had after the election of Pope Leo XVI was the following: What made him choose “Leo” as his papal name? There have been 13 other popes in history name Leo. Was it the most recent Pope Leo that intrigued him? Was it perhaps the very first pope who had that name, Pope Leo the Great, from the 5th century? Or was it another Leo from the Church’s history?

Fortunately, Pope Leo XIV recently answered the question—it is indeed mainly because of the most recent pope with that name, Pope Leo XIII (the 13th). Leo XIII was pope from 1878 until 1903, which means that he led the Church into the 20th century. He is known for many things, having been pope for over 25 years. One of his most famous accomplishments, though, is a very important document that he wrote in 1891. The document, known by its Latin title, is called *Rerum Novarum*, and is considered to be the foundation of the Church’s modern social teaching. He addressed such topics as fair wages for workers, safe working conditions, trade unions, the right to private property, among many other topics. The great novelty of the document was that for the first time, the Church was addressing social issues in the light of the first great Industrial Revolution.

Pope Leo XIV has said that this is one of the reasons (but not the only one!) he took the name Leo. With the Church well into the 21st century, he recognizes the need to address social issues in the context of modern technology. Specifically, he identified a “new” industrial revolution that has been brought on the field of Artificial Intelligence (AI). In the same way the Pope Leo XIII helped to shape the Church’s response to 19th century technology, Pope Leo XIV senses a responsibility he has to guide the Church’s response to 21st century technology. Certainly not an easy task, but a very important one!

A few months ago, I had written a few bulletin pieces about Pope Francis and his views on AI. It will now be fascinating to see how this continues with Pope Leo XIV. Let us pray that the Holy Spirit will bless him with the wisdom and prudence that he needs for this important and demanding role.

Habemus Papam! Pope Leo XIV named 267th successor of Peter

Cardinal Robert Francis Prevost of the United States has been elected the 267th pope and has stepped onto the balcony of St. Peter's Basilica as the new leader of the world's 1.4 billion Catholics.

He's now known as Pope Leo XIV. Prevost, 69, from Chicago, Illinois, is the first ever pope from the United States.

It's been a long while since we had a pope with this name: last Leo, Leo XIII, was elected in 1878 and served until his death in 1903.

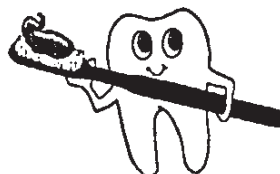
