Dear parishioners,

Next weekend (June 21st/22nd) we will celebrate Corpus Christi, the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ. This is a beautiful feast that began in the 13th century, in order to emphasize the great gift that we have in the Holy Eucharist. At the time, there were some who felt that there was no need for such a feast. After all, every Mass is a celebration of the Holy Eucharist, they argued, so why come up with another extra feast? The problem was that many people were taking the gift of the Holy Eucharist for granted. The belief in the Real Presence had grown weak. People were not acting as though they believe that Jesus himself is really, truly present in Holy Communion.

The creation of a new feast was therefore welcomed by many, as it would strengthen faith in the Holy Eucharist as well as honour Our Lord in the most holy sacrament.

Special traditions then developed around the feast of Corpus Christi. Some of the major ones include Eucharistic processions (even in the city streets!), 40-hour devotions, and perpetual adoration chapels.

On Corpus Christi weekend here at Holy Name, we will begin in a beautiful way—on Saturday, June 21st, our young boys and girls will be making their First Holy Communion at an 11am Mass. What a great way to celebrate by receiving Jesus for the first (of many!) times in their young lives. And then at our regular weekend celebrations, we will conclude each Mass by having a time of silent adoration of the Eucharist. After the final blessing, instead of the usual closing procession, the monstrance and candles will be brought to the altar for the Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament. We will sing a short hymn, and then Jesus will remain on the altar for about an hour after Mass. I encourage everyone to spend a few moments in silent prayer after the weekend Masses. It could just be for a few minutes, or you might want to leave for a bit and then return. Of course, many will want to stay for the entire hour, adoring Jesus, praying to Jesus, bringing to Jesus our various needs.

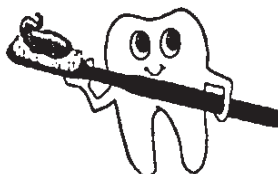
