Dear parishioners,

I would like to draw your attention to the special feast days that we will be celebrating in the Church over the coming week. On June 24th, we celebrate the Solemnity of the Birth of St. John the Baptist. It is noteworthy that John the Baptist has a special feast day for his birth. Other than him, only Our Lord and Our Lady have that special privilege. Clearly, John the Baptist is seen as having such great importance. We might not often think of having a special devotion to him or invoking his intercession in time of need, but we can be sure that his prayers are very powerful. The feast day is also a special day for French Canadians. The 24th of June, Saint-Jean-Baptiste-Day, is a day when our francophone brothers and sisters celebrate their language and traditions. In Quebec, the day is even a public holiday and is considered as their *fête nationale*. Everything about John the Baptist is meant to point us to Jesus. It is fitting, then, that just a few days after celebrating the birth of John the Baptist we will celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus (June 27th). Here at Holy Name, we have a beautiful stained-glass window of the Sacred Heart (next to the statue of Our Lady) as well as a beautiful statue of Jesus and his Sacred Heart (close to the elevator entrance). These are helpful reminders of the deeper truth that the feast is meant to convey—the unconditional love of Jesus, symbolized by a heart that is pierced with sorrow and aflame with compassion.

The month will come to its conclusion on June 29th with the Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul. This is one of those years when this particular feast falls on a Sunday, and so we will have the chance to celebrate it as an entire parish community. It is also a fun coincidence that we celebrate the feast just a few months after the election of a new pope. As we honour the Princes of the Apostles, we pray for the current Successor of Peter, Pope Leo XIV. Both Peter and Paul are great examples of those who, despite their weaknesses and mistakes, were able to profoundly experience the mercy of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. May all of us be drawn into that same experience of love.

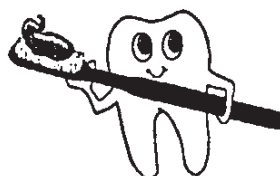

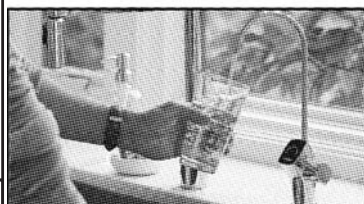
