Dear parishioners,

The 25th Sunday in Ordinary Time has been designated in the Archdiocese of Toronto as Stewardship Sunday. The aim of the day is to focus on our God-given gifts and talents and to see how they can be used to serve the parish community. We often think of our service as stewards in terms of joining a particular ministry, group, or parish activity. It is, of course, wonderful to consider stewardship in this way. However, I would like to also encourage everyone to broaden the perspective of both stewardship as well as parish participation. There is a beautiful document from the Second Vatican Council that describes the role of the laity in the Church and in the world. The document is from the early 1960s but it is very relevant and appropriate to us today. A short phrase from the document states that "the laity must take up the renewal of the temporal order as their own special obligation". What exactly is the temporal order? It refers to just about every aspect of our lives in the world outside the walls of the parish church—work, school, family, friends, sports and leisure, politics, and so on. It means that the primary role of the laity in the Church is to bring their Christian faith outside the walls of the parish church and into every aspect of their lives. Stewardship, then, does not primarily mean getting involved in a parish activity or group. In fact, according to Vatican II, this is not what is most important. The key part of stewardship is to gain spiritual strength from participation in the parish Mass—from the Eucharist, from the Word of God, from the community—and then to go back into the world to bring the light of the Gospel wherever we are. It could be that we do not get involved in any specific parish activity, but we are living our lives as Catholics in a very deep way wherever we are...at home, at work, at school. People recognize something different about us when they meet us; people are touched by our Catholic faith, sometimes even without words. When this happens, then we are living stewardship in its most important dimension.

Let us consider this fundamental aspect of stewardship. Am I drawing strength from the Holy Mass here at the parish in order to bring the beauty of my faith into the world?
