Thanksgiving

For wealth and plenty in the land, For faith in God's sustaining hand, For every blessing great and small We thank the giver of it all.





Dear parishioners,

Many of us are happy to welcome the Thanksgiving Day long weekend. In addition to an extra day of rest from work or school, this is a time to gather with family and friends. We are also well aware that there are many in our own community who struggle with difficulties and needs. They must also be kept in mind and assisted in whatever way we can.

There is a beautiful prayer that is recited at every Mass, called the **Preface**. It takes place between the Offertory and the Holy Holy Holy. Very often, it begins with the following words addressed to the Heavenly Father: "It is truly right and just, our duty and our salvation, always and everywhere to give you thanks, Lord, holy Father."

Are we able to give thanks to God "always and everywhere"? This is neither easy nor obvious. We typically give thanks to God for the good things and the blessings that we have received: good health, well-being of our family, comforts and security in life, good weather, success at work and at school. It is very important to do this. Yes, we often work hard and put in our own sacrifices to earn these gifts. But, as people of faith, we also recognize that it is also by the loving hand of God that we are able to receive these blessings.

When things are difficult, though, it is not as easy to give thanks. It does not even seem normal to be grateful for suffering or hardships. Yet, somehow, we are asked to be drawn into that prayer at every Mass, giving thanks "always and everywhere".

What does it mean to give thanks to God when it seems that we have nothing to be thankful for, only perhaps to complain? For sure, we can recognize and acknowledge our pain, even expressing that to God. Then, we can ask God for the strength to endure and persevere, and the insights to understand why these things are happening. And finally, we can even beg God for the grace to accept and offer up our sufferings. When we can offer and unite our sufferings to Jesus on the Cross—which we do at every Mass—then in a mysterious and powerful way, God can transform these very sufferings into sources of blessings.

It certainly is not easy, but with God's gracious help, we can indeed give thanks "always and everywhere".
