Dear parishioners,

During the first 8 days of November, the Church extends a special blessing for the deceased. The entire month is dedicated to the faithful departed, but these first 8 days have a special grace. Specifically, the blessing is that a plenary indulgence can be obtained on each one of these days if we visit a cemetery and pray for the deceased there. What exactly is a plenary indulgence? We understand indulgences in the context of the reality of sin, the consequence of punishment that our sins bring about, and – most importantly – the richness of God's mercy. When we commit sins, we can be confident of God's forgiveness when we confess our sins and show our sorrow for them. Nevertheless, our sins are concrete actions that have consequences and effects in the world and on our souls. As a result, even after forgiveness, we are called upon to do what we can to make up for these negative consequences. Another way to describe this is using the expression "temporal punishment" due to sin. It might sound harsh, but it expresses the truth that even after death, a period of purification might be needed before we can enter into eternal life. This necessity comes from the need to make amends, so to speak, for our sinful actions in life, but even more so, to enable our souls to be purified such that we can be ever more prepared to enjoy the fullness of heaven.

Fortunately, the Church does not leave the faithful departed to take care of this purification alone. We who are still living can offer Masses and do other spiritual works for them, and this is of great benefit for their souls. To encourage this, the Church often grants special "indulgences" to certain spiritual works. Thus, by performing a certain spiritual work, we can then apply the merits of this work to the deceased. This assists them greatly in their time of purification, basically helping them on their way to heaven. To obtain the indulgence, we are also asked to go to confession, receive Holy Communion, and pray for the Pope's intentions.

During the first 8 days of November, we can obtain an indulgence for the faithful departed by visiting a cemetery and praying there for our loved ones. Let us begin this month of November by taking advantage of this great source of God's grace.
