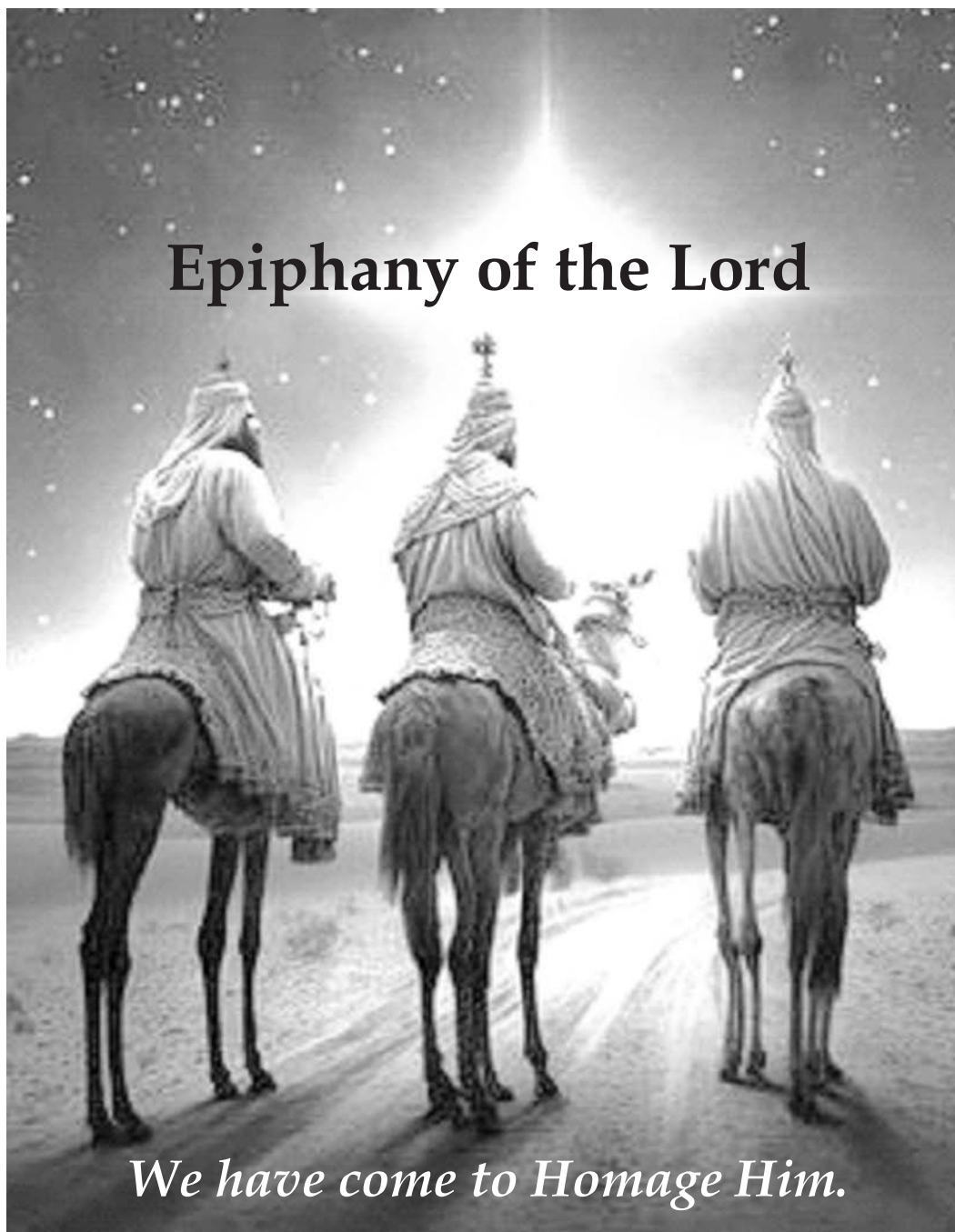

Epiphany of the Lord



We have come to Homage Him.

Dear parishioners,

The first week of the year brings us to the celebration of a beloved Canadian saint – St. Andre of Montreal. He is more commonly known as Brother Andre, as he was a religious brother of the Holy Cross Congregation. Here at Holy Name Parish, we are blessed with a beautiful statue and small shrine to St. Andre, under the statue of St. Joseph. For a number of years, the pastoral care of the parish was entrusted to priests of the Holy Name congregation. To commemorate the momentous occasion of Brother Andre's canonization in 2010, the statue and shrine were commissioned.

Brother Andre spent the majority of his religious life as the porter for his community. This means that he would welcome visitors to the community and attend to their initial needs. Fairly soon, he was recognized as a man of deep faith and prayer. He would often pray with those who came to visit, especially those who were sick. Eventually, it was reported that many people experience healing of their sicknesses after visiting Brother Andre and praying with him. He himself never took the credit; almost always, he would entrust the visitors and their needs to the intercession of St. Joseph. As the years went on, his reputation grew throughout Montreal, and large numbers of visitors would come to see him. A larger community house was soon needed to accommodate the crowds. Eventually, the new shrine built became the great St. Joseph's Oratory, one of today's major landmarks in Montreal. When Brother Andre died in 1945, it was reported that almost one million people came to pay their respects.

Every morning when I come into our church to pray, I go around to the statues and ask the saints for their prayers. When I reach St. Andre, I ask him to pray for all those who come through the doors of our parish church. I also ask him to pray for all those who do not come through the doors, in the hopes that eventually they will!

Through the prayers of St. Andre, may all of us experience the protective love of St. Joseph, that they may both guide us to a safe and holy New Year.

Tip Tap Pay is changing the way people give.

It's SIMPLE:

1. TAP your card on the device

(Each tap will charge your card)



2. After your first TAP, if you would like a TAX RECEIPT, SCAN parish QR Code & register your card right away!

(you only need to register your card once)

Each 'tip tap' gift that you make with your registered card will be available for an end-of-year tax receipt



FAQ

How do I donate different amounts?

- You can only donate the amount that is labelled on the 'tip tap' device.
- However, you can tap the 'tip tap' device multiple times to donate more.
- You can tap a \$5-device 4 times to make a \$20 gift to your parish.

Is my data stored in the device?

- No. The 'tip tap' device does not store any information. It also cannot be hacked as any tampering triggers a signal that shuts down the device.

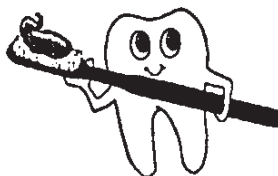
