Dear parishioners,

This weekend the Archdiocese of Toronto commemorates Marriage Sunday. It is something that Cardinal Collins instituted here in Toronto several years ago as a special weekend of the year to focus our thoughts on marriage, its meaning, and its importance in our lives. One of the special events that happens is an anniversary Mass. At St. Michael's Cathedral Basilica, couples from across the Archdiocese of Toronto will be gathering to celebrate Mass with one of the bishops. These couples are celebrating milestone anniversaries this year—25 years, 40 years, 50 years, 60 years and beyond! We congratulate all of these couples, we thank God for their witness of faithfulness, and we pray for continued blessings upon them all. It is also important this weekend to keep in mind those who struggle in some way in the context of marriage. We hold close to our hearts widows and widowers who are mourning the loss of a spouse. We think of those who are having difficulties within their marriage. Relationships are never easy, and the burdens of life can often become overwhelming. We pray for couples who have undergone separation and divorce, that they will be able to experience God's loving presence. In all of these situations, the occasions where marriage is celebrated can perhaps be particularly painful, almost serving as reminders of the wounds that they are trying to heal. On Marriage Sunday, we can everyone in mind and in our prayers – thanking God for the many blessings that our anniversary couples have received, and beseeching God for the healing graces that so many others are seeking. In the Bible, the image of marriage is often used to describe the relationship that God seeks to have with us, his people. Jesus uses the image of a marriage banquet to describe the Kingdom of Heaven. St. Paul uses marriage as a wonderful comparison of the relationship that Jesus seeks to have with his bride, the Church. In good and times and in bad, in sickness and in health, may the Lord accompany his beloved people and lead us – after the road of life that is often rocky and full of potholes! – to the fullness of joy that he promises.

Tip Tap Pay is changing the way people give.

It's SIMPLE:

1. **TAP your card on the device**
(Each tap will charge your card)



2. After your first TAP, if you would like a **TAX RECEIPT, SCAN parish QR Code & register your card right away!**
(you only need to register your card once)

Each 'tiptap' gift that you make with your registered card will be available for an end-of-year tax receipt



FAQ

How do I donate different amounts?

- You can only donate the amount that is labelled on the 'tiptap' device.
- However, you can tap the 'tiptap' device multiple times to donate more.
- You can tap a \$5-device 4 times to make a \$20 gift to your parish.

Is my data stored in the device?

- No. The 'tiptap' device does not store any information. It also cannot be hacked as any tampering triggers a signal that shuts down the device.

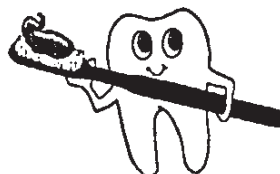
