Dear parishioners,

This weekend's Feast of the Most Holy Trinity has a certain connection with last Sunday's Feast of Pentecost. The aim of the Holy Spirit in our lives is to take us into the heart of God, which means that the Spirit unites us to Jesus and to God the Father. Because of the Holy Spirit, we can acknowledge Jesus as our Lord (1 Cor 12:3); because of the Holy Spirit, we can call God our Father (Rom 8:15). The Sign of the Cross is the simple but beautiful and meaningful ritual that we have that reminds us of this. We are under the protection of the Cross and covered by the love of the Most Holy Trinity: In the Name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.

Another interesting point about the Feast is that in the Church, there is a religious community that was actually founded with the Trinity as its patron. The community is called the Trinitarians, and they go back to the late 12th century. They were founded by two saints: St. John of Matha and St. Felix of Valois. The major work that the members of this community did at that time was to assist Christians who had been captured and put into slavery because of their faith. It was challenging and dangerous work, but they felt motivated to carry out this great act of charity.

Over the centuries, the type of work that they do has changed, but they always try to maintain that original focus of assisting those who are suffering greatly. Although they do not have a strong presence in Canada, they are present in many other countries of the world where they are involved in various works of charity.

We might sometimes take for granted our belief in God as Trinity. It is interesting, then, to learn about the Trinitarians, whose work shows us what our faith in the Trinity should lead us to do. God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit are immersed in a relation of infinite love!

Therefore, as Christians, our faith in God the Holy Trinity should lead us to strive to spread that love in the world in whatever way we can.
