Dear parishioners,

There was an interesting conference last week in the United States organized by the Catholic Media Association. It was the annual conference to gather together journalists, editors, publishers, and communications professionals, all of whom either work for Catholic media outlets or who are Catholics who work in the secular media. Not surprisingly, one of the main conferences had to do with artificial intelligence and its effect on Catholic communication.

Two points came to my mind when reading about the conference.

First of all, the Catholic Church always tries to be involved in every aspect of human life. Whether it is with media professionals or any other type of work, the Church often has a presence in these fields. As we recall from last week, even sports is an area in which the Church wants to be involved. It reflects the fact that God has created our world and our society, and there should be no area of human experience that is separate from our life of faith. We never want the Gospel and our Catholic experience to be limited to what happens within the walls of the parish church.

The second point has to do with the media specifically. We cannot ignore the fact that the media has a very influential and valuable role in our society. So much of our information comes from media sources, which are changing so rapidly with technology. Those who work in the media have a great responsibility, and so it is important that we pray for them and even offer insights from our faith perspective. Toronto is very much a media center for our country, and so the Archdiocese of Toronto has a Communications Office that works hard at keeping a good relationship with our media sources. One bishop once said that it is often through the media that we can reach people most directly. Let us, then, pray for all those who work in the media, that the Holy Spirit will guide them in their duties. And for the rest of us, in whatever type of work we are involved in, may the Holy Spirit also guide us, so that we will discover both the presence of God and the beautiful diversity of this world that he has created!
